


ÜLEMISTE CITY RADAR ECONOMY


There are nearly 500 companies with more than 15 000 employees in Ülemiste City. The added value produced by our companies nearly quadrupled during 2015–2022. Today, Ülemiste City has grown into the third economic city in Estonia, following Tallinn and Tartu.





Ülemiste City as a Growth Environment



213 out of all the companies in Ülemiste City have been here since 2019. The increase of added value index of companies (2019=100%), when compared to the added value index of all Estonian companies, shows that the added value produced by the companies on campus has increased substantially faster than anywhere else during the observed period.















Third Economy in Estonia

Compared to the business sector labor taxes of all Estonian cities, Ülemiste City only pays less taxes than Tallinn (58%) and Tartu (6.5%) but more than Pärnu (2.4%).


